Featured Topic: Linking External Data Files to Arkansas Healthcare Transparency Initiative (HTI) Data

External File Linking

- External file linking is a supplemental process available to data requesters that enables the association of the Arkansas Healthcare Transparency Initiative (HTI) data with an external analytic file based on a Study ID match
- The external file linking process requires additional agreements with ACHI

External Linking Approaches

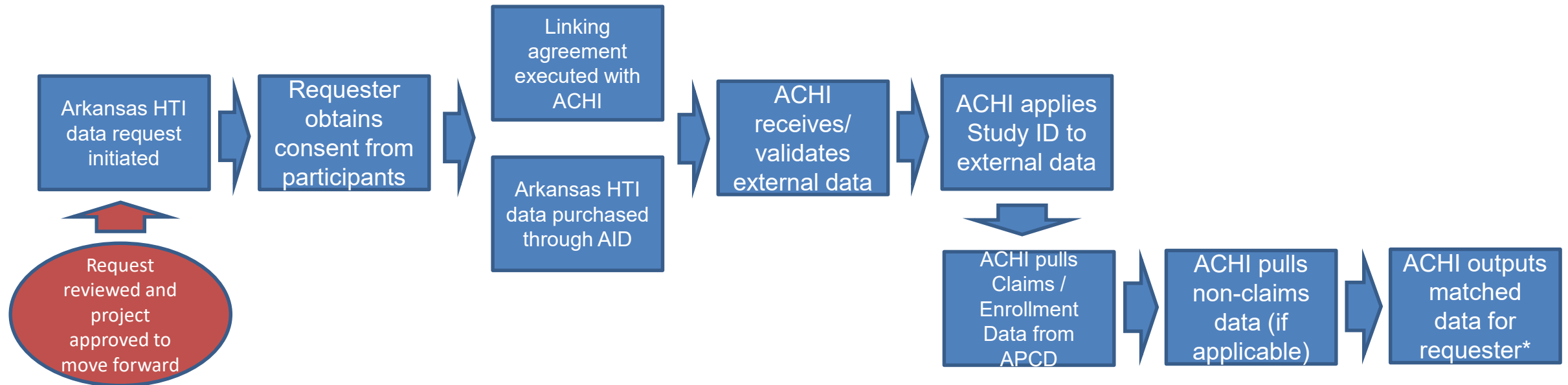
- External linking projects utilize either the re-identification approach or the non-re-identification approach; these linkage approaches *cannot* be combined
- If re-identification is required:
 - *Signed participant consent must be obtained*
 - Identifiers can be returned with the data
- If re-identification is not required or consent cannot be obtained:
 - Identifiers cannot be returned with the data

Re-identification

- Act 1233 of 2015 prohibits re-identification of individuals using Arkansas HTI data
- *If re-identification is required, special consent must be obtained*
- Data requesters must use a specific consent form approved by the HTI Board and AID commissioner
- The form is required to maintain consent documentation, subject to audit by AID

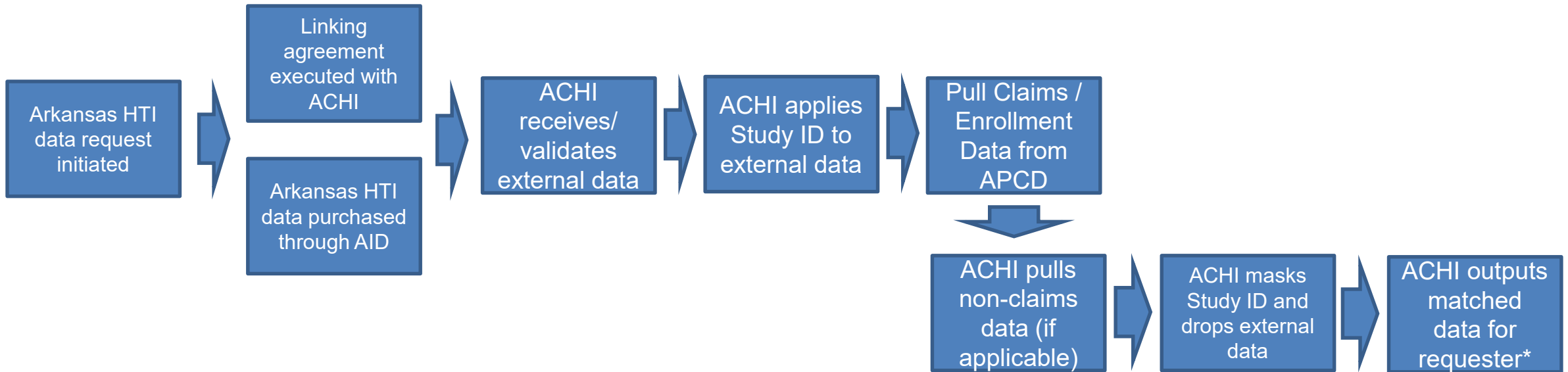
The consent form can be used as a stand-alone form or may be included in a requester's Research Authorization Form, required for researchers with IRB approved studies that require consent.

Colorado APCD

- The Colorado APCD is managed by the Center for Improving Value in Health Care (CIVHC)
- Dashboards have recently been updated to include a more robust ‘Shop for Care’ section
 - Services by ZIP
 - Average price and price range
 - Quality – patient experience and overall hospital quality

Maine APCD Dashboard

- CompareMaine is managed by Maine Health Data Organization (MHDO manages Maine's APCD) and Maine Quality Forum
- CompareMaine is one of the most mature APCD dashboards and features:
 - Top 5 procedures searched for
 - Service cost and quality comparisons
 - Facility information
 - Robust methodology section

New Hampshire APCD Dashboard

- NH Health Cost tool is built from the NH APCD and is managed by New Hampshire Insurance Department and NH Department of Health and Human Services
- It features:
 - Cost comparison by procedure
 - Includes Medical and Dental procedures
 - Quality of Care measures
 - Robust methodology section
